

# BREEDS OF DAIRY CATTLE IN INDIA

## 1) RED SINDHI:



The breed originated in the Sindh province of Pakistan and widely kept as milch cow in India, Pakistan, Bangladesh and Sri Lanka. They are heat and disease resistant.

Colour: red- brown.

Body weight : Males: 530 kg

Females: 325 Kg.

Height: Males: 132 cm

Female: 115 cm.

Average milk yield: 12 litres per day.

The breed originated in Punjab region along the India Pakistan border. It is heat resistant, tick resistant, and is noted for high resistance against parasites ( both internal and external ). It is kept for both milk and draught purpose.

The breed originated from Andhra Pradesh, India. It is known for its rapid growth rate, and resistance to heat and diseases. It has great demand as it is said to be resistant to F.M.D and Mad Cow Disease. It is a triple purpose breed and is reared for milk meat and draught.

#### **4) GIR:**



Mostly found in Gir forest of Gujarat, hence the name. They are also known as Desan, Gujarati etc. they are known for their resistance to stress conditions and resistance to several tropical diseases. The breed is also used to drag heavy loads. Age at first calving at 39 to 50 months inter calving period of 14 to 18 months.

Colour: Red with shades varying from dark red to light.

Weight: males – 544 kgs

Females – 310 kgs

Average milk yield: 12 liters / day.

Colour : Usually spotted black and white.

Average milk yield: 636 to 1320 kgs per lactation.

Weight: Male: 590 kg

Female: 295 kg

## 7) KANKREJ:



It is an Indian breed of cattle which originated in the region of Rann of Kutch in Gujarat and neighboring Rajasthan. It is also found in Sind province of Pakistan. It is also known as Waded or Waged. This breed has unique characteristics like resistance to tick fever, heat stress and tuberculosis.

Colour : Varies from Silver grey to iron grey and steel black.

Milk yield: 1738 kg per lactation

Weight: Males – 590 kg.

Females – 431 kg.

## 8) KRISHNA VALLEY:



Originated from the black cotton soil of the water shed of the river Krishna in Karnataka. The animals are large having a massive frame with tail almost reaching the ground. Bullocks of this breed are used for slow ploughing and valued for good working qualities. The females are fair milkers.

Colour: Grey white with a darker shade on the front quarters and hind quarters.

Milk yield: 916 kgs per lactation period.
