ANNUAL ADMINISTRATIVE REPORT 2022-23.

1. Function and Objective: -

The Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary is entrusted with the responsibility of all aspect of Livestock and Poultry Development, like, production, processing and marketing of livestock and poultry and their products through augmentation of production of milk, meat, eggs and wool; animal health care and prevention of animal diseases, creation of suitable infrastructure for breeding, feeding and management of livestock and poultry, processing of milk, meat and eggs and marketing of livestock and livestock products. Besides, the Department is engaged in providing the required training and extension support to livestock producers so as to promote scientific rearing of livestock and poultry amongst them with consequent generation of employment avenues in the rural areas.

The Annual Administrative Report contains information on Veterinary and Animal Husbandry activities taken up by this Department during the year 2020-21. The activities centre round the broad objective of (1) Providing protection to the Livestock and Poultry population from the ravages of contagious and non-contagious diseases through treatment and preventive measures; (2) Improvement of the level of production and potentiality of livestock in the State by introducing improved breed, and ensuring better Animal Husbandry practices by adopting approaches of extension and research; (3) Building up adequate technical and training facilities and (4) Encourage to set up Livestock Industry in the State.

To intensify the facilities for treatment and preventive measures through Vaccination, a network of Hospitals, Dispensaries, Mobile Dispensaries and Aid Centres have been established covering a vast area of the State. In addition to these, Schemes like Animal Diseases Surveillance, Rinderpest Eradication, Foot and Mouth Diseases Control, Systematic control of Livestock diseases of National Importance have also been sanctioned and implemented during the year under report. Thousands of animals were treated by the technical Staff of Veterinary Institution. Apart from treatment of animals, these institutions look after other aspect of livestock development through preventive inoculations, artificial insemination, removal of undesired Scrub-bulls, recording of Improved breed and development of poultry population both in Public and Private Sector, etc.

On Animal Husbandry Sector, Schemes of far-reaching effect like Intensive Cattle Development Project, Indo-Danish Project, Cross Breeding Schemes, Fodder Development, Piggery Development, Sheep and Goat Development and Poultry Development have been implemented. Thirteen Poultry Farms, Thirteen Pig Farms, Four Cattle Breeding Farms and one Buffalo Farm were functioning during the year under report. These farms supplied improved Breeding stock to the people to take up Livestock and Poultry farming to substantiate their income and also for augmenting the production of Meat, Milk and Eggs. Objective and Aims of the Major Programmes are given separately at page 8 to 13.

4.2. Cattle Development: - This is an integrated programme of Cattle Development including breeding and management practices. The main objective of the scheme is to enhance Milk production in the state by upgrading the local stock through cross breeding by adopting improved breeding practices by means of artificial insemination. Four Cattle breeding farms were established in the State with Exotic breeds like Jersey and Holstein-Friesian for maintenance of superior germplasm and production of inputs for supply to farmers, etc. A Buffalo Farm at Songsak is functioning with Murrah Breed. Stock position and production of Cattle & Buffalo farms is shown in Table -1.

(a) Under Intensive Cattle Development Project, Shillong and Tura: - 9.55 thousand numbers of Improved calves were produced during the year in different areas of the State through Artificial Insemination programmes implemented under this Scheme. During the year under report 20.359 thousand artificial inseminations were carried out in the State to produce improved calves for augmenting Milk production. Frozen semen Technology has been introduced for Artificial Insemination programmes. Two Liquid Nitrogen Plants have been installed at Upper Shillong & Tura for such purposes. LNP produced during the year 37.242 thousand litres.

(b) The Department has been implementing various schemes for Cattle development which include distribution of calves, heifer, cows and young bulls to the selected farmers falling under different categories of General, Educated Un-employed youth and also for Small / Marginal Farmers and Agricultural Laborers. Implementation given in Annexure-I

4.3 Poultry Development: - The objective of the scheme is to meet the requirement of breeding stock, table and hatching eggs. This also aims at improving the local breed by distribution of improved breed. **13 poultry farms** have been established with the purpose of demonstration and production. Regional Poultry Breeding Farm, Kyrdemkulai, Central Hatchery cum Poultry Farm, Umsning and Poultry Farms at Rongkhon, Jowai & Nongstoin have hatcheries for producing chicks for distribution to different District Poultry Farms and the farmers and other integrated private agencies for extension of poultry development programmes in the State. A broiler chick production unit

is also one of the objectives under poultry development to produce 1(one) lakh broiler chicks per annum to meet the local demand. Achievements of Poultry Farms are shown in the Table -2.

2. Out of Thirteen Poultry Farms established in the State, one Farm namely, Poultry Farm Phulbari is not functioning. Efforts are being made to revive this farm.

(a) The Regional Poultry Breeding Farm and Broiler Farm established at Kyrdemkulai produced **59.7** thousand Layer Chicks. These Chicks were supplied to Government Poultry farms established at different Districts as well as to private Farms for raising their stock.

(b) Schemes for Subsidy for Poultry unit General, Educated Un-employed Youth and Assistance to SF/MF/AL for rearing of Poultry is also in existence. Implementation is given in Annexure-I

4.4 Piggery Development: - Pig is one of the most important species among the small animal in the State and pig rearing is the most common occupation with the tribal people of the State. The suitability of the climate, fondness to pork among the major section of the State population and availability of good market for pork promise wide possibilities of development of the pig industry in the State. But the main drawback in this sphere is that most of the farmers prefer to rear inferior quality of stock of non-descript breeds. About 88% of the total villages reared are non-descript local breed and only 12% reared Cross Bred pig.

With a view to upgrade local stock, the Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary has taken up schemes to introduce improved breeds of pigs such as Durock, Hampshire, etc. These improved breeds of pigs are kept at Government pig farms located in every district for the purpose of demonstration as well as for producing better stock for supply to the interested farmers. A Regional Pig Breeding Farm was established at Kyrdemkulai during the 7th Plan period in the year 1986-87 with financial assistance from N.E.C. The farm, which is now under the State plan, is maintaining Hampshire breed pigs for scientific breeding purpose. The farm produced piglets and supply to all the district farms for raising and multiplication and for supply of these piglets to farmers. Under Piggery Development there were 13 (Thirteen) pig farms including the Regional Pig Breeding Farm Kyrdemkulai established in the State. However, Artificial Insemination in pig has been introduced at Pig Farm, Nongpiur with the objectives to: i) create facilities for Artificial Insemination in Pigs at door step of farmers, ii) improve production and protection of livestock as well as to ensure better practices in management, breeding and feeding, iii) promote scientific method of rearing of Pigs and iv) improvement of genetic variability of indigenous population. The stock position and achievement of Government Pig Farms is shown in Table -3.

4.5 Sheep and Goat Development: - The objective of this Scheme is to improve the local goats by introducing superior germ plasm. The Goat Farm Nongshillong had a Total Stock reared of **63 numbers** with **2 Bucks** and **39 Doe**, with a production of **30 Kids**. While the Sheep & Goat Farm, Saitsama had a Total Stock **40** Number of sheep reared with 2 **Rams** and **16 Ewes** with production of **7 (Seven) Lambs**, and a Total Stock of **15** Number of goats reared with **2 buck and 5 Doe**, with production of **2 Kids**.

i. <u>Rabbit Farm Nongpiur</u> was established with an objective to produce the breeding stocks for supplying as laboratory animals and as pet. The farm maintained Soviet Chincilla and New Zealand White breeds of Rabbit with a **Total stock** of **434** out of which **271** number were parents' stock and have the annual rabbit production of **768** Nos.

4.6. Feed and Fodder Development: - Four Fodder Demonstration Farms and one Seed production farm have been established in the State to meet the requirement of Fodder and Fodder seed. These farms produced **1995.6 tonnes** of Fodder during the year.

i. Subsidy to Farmers for Livestock & Poultry Feed: - Subsidy for distribution of balance livestock and poultry feed to farmers through registered Livestock and Poultry Co-operative societies including individual farmers is implemented in the State in order to encourage them for rearing of Livestock and Poultry. Detail is given in Annexure-I.

ii. **882.11 tonnes** quantity of feed received during the year and **900.47 tonnes** of mixed feed at Feed Mill Bhoi and Tura were received and supplied to Government Livestock and Poultry farms.

iii. **Numbers** of Sample of feed ingredients and **348** Number of Samples tested during the year for checking the nutritive value.

4.7 Administrative Investigation and Statistics: - Sample Survey for estimation of Major Livestock Products was taken up during the year with an objective to estimate the production level of major livestock products such as milk, meat and eggs as well as to study the utilization of livestock and poultry production and management practices adopted in the State.

4.8 Veterinary Research: - Animal Disease Investigation was taken up as routine check-up in all Government farms and attended the cases of disease outbreak in the State and accordingly. Specimens were collected for Laboratory test and investigation. Under Vaccine Depot, various kinds of vaccines were procured and distributed to different Veterinary Institutions for conducting vaccination programmes against specific diseases of Livestock & Poultry.

4.9 Education and training: - **16** (Sixteen) students were newly sponsored by State Government during the year for studying B.V.Sc Course outside the State. The total numbers of B.V.Sc. Students, which include existing students, were **64 Nos and 16 Nos** respectively who continued their studies during the year up to March 2023.

4.10 VFA Certificate Course: **31 students** who were given training for VFA Certificate Course at VFA Training School Kyrdemkulai during the year under report.

4.11 Vocational Training: - Vocational Training Centre have been established in the State, one at Kyrdemkulai; Ri Bhoi District and one at Tura; West Garo Hills District and one at Upper Shillong, East Khasi Hills. The newly created training centres at Manai, West Khasi Hills and Khliehtyrshi, West Jaintia Hills were functional during the year. The objective is to impart training to the farmers in proper management, feeding and health care of Livestock and Poultry. During the year **2883 farmers** were given Training at the Vocational Training Centre at Khasi Hills and Garo Hills for Livestock & Poultry rearing and management, etc.

Centrally Sponsored Scheme and Central Sector Schemes:

1. The following Centrally Sponsored Schemes continued to function during the year under report: -

1.1 Livestock Health & Disease Control (LH&DC): The overall aim of the Livestock Health & Disease Control scheme is to improve the animal health sector by way of implementation of prophylactic vaccination programmes against various diseases of livestock and poultry, capacity building, disease surveillance and strengthening of veterinary infrastructure. It is envisaged that the Scheme will ultimately lead to prevention & control, subsequently eradicating the diseases, increased access to veterinary services, higher productivity from animals, boosting up of trade in livestock and poultry, in livestock and poultry products and improving socioeconomic status of livestock and poultry farmers.

The LH&DC Scheme continued to be implemented in the State with the following seven components:

- (1) Assistance to States for Control of Animal Disease (ASCAD): Assistance given from GOI is provided for control of economically important and zoonotic diseases of livestock and poultry by immunization, strengthening of the existing State Veterinary Biological Production Units and of the existing Disease Diagnostic Laboratories as well as for providing in-service training to veterinarians and para-veterinarians. Funds are provided also for vaccination against canine rabies and for control of endo-parasites in cattle and buffaloes
- (2) Peste des Petits Ruminants Control Programme (PPR-CP): PPR, also known as sheep and goat plague, is being implemented by utilizing the provided Central assistance for vaccination and surveillance of susceptible sheep & goat population, thereby giving them protection against this dreaded and economically important disease of sheep and goats
- (3) Establishment and strengthening of existing Veterinary Hospitals and Dispensaries (ESVHD): Assistance from GOI under this component is to help the State establish new veterinary hospitals and dispensaries, strengthen / equip the existing ones, as well as run mobile veterinary ambulances.
- (4) Classical Swine Fever Control Programme (CSF-CP): This disease is a major constraint to the development of pig farming in the North East part of the country where pig farming is a major source of livelihood for most households. Therefore, the Central assistance provided by the GOI is utilized to control the CSF disease in pigs, by providing vaccination against the disease to the pig population of the State.
- (5) National Project on Rinderpest Surveillance and Monitoring (NPRSM): Assistance received under this component is utilized to strengthen surveillance in order to maintain the country's freedom from Rinderpest & Contagious Bovine Pleuro-Pneumonia (CBPP) infections, which were achieved in May 2006 and May 2007, respectively.
- (6) National Animal Disease Reporting System (NADRS): On-line system of animal disease reporting linking each Block, District and State Headquarters to the Central Disease Reporting and Monitoring Unit in New Delhi.

(7) **Professional Efficiency Development (PED):** Under this component, Central assistance is given to the State Veterinary Councils to carry out their statutory functions under the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 as well as to carry out Continuous Veterinary Education (CVE) for in-service veterinarians.

1.2 National Livestock Mission (NLM): Launched all over India, including Meghalaya, during 2014-15, the National Livestock Mission (NLM) continued to be implemented in our State during year under report. The Mission is designed to cover all the activities required to ensure quantitative and qualitative improvement in livestock production systems and capacity building of all stakeholder. The Mission covers everything germane to improvement of livestock productivity and support projects and initiatives required for achieving such initiatives.

The NLM comprises of the following four Sub-Missions:

- (1) Sub-Mission on Livestock Development: The sub-mission on Livestock Development includes activities to address the concerns for overall development of livestock species including poultry, other than cattle and buffalo, with a holistic approach. Risk Management component of the sub-mission will, however, also cover cattle and buffalo along with other major and minor livestock
- (2) Sub-Mission on Pig Development in North-Eastern Region: In order to support for the all-round development of the piggery sector in the NE region, this component was taken up as a sub- mission of NLM. The sub-mission will strive to forge synergies of research and development organizations through appropriate interventions, as may be required for holistic development of pigs in the State, including genetic improvement, health cover and post-harvest operations.
- (3) Sub-Mission on Feed and Fodder Development: The Sub-Mission is designed to address the problems of scarcity of animal feed and fodder resources, to give a push to the livestock sector making it a competitive enterprise for India, and also to harness its export potential. The sub-mission will especially focus on increasing both production and productivity of fodder and feed through adoption of improved and appropriate technologies best suited to specific agro-climatic region in both arable and non-arable areas.
- (4) Sub-Mission on Skill Development, Technology Transfer and Extension: The extension machinery at field level for livestock activities is not adequately strengthened. As a result, farmers are not able to adopt the technologies developed by research institutions. The adoption of new technologies and practices requires linkages between stakeholders. The sub-mission will provide a platform to develop, adopt or adapt the technologies including frontline field demonstrations in collaboration with farmers, researchers and extension workers, etc. wherever it is not possible to achieve this through existing arrangements.

2. The following Central Sector Scheme continued to function during the year under report:

2.1 National Animal Disease Control Programme for FMD and Brucellosis (NADCP): National Animal Disease Control Programme for FMD and Brucellosis

(NADCP) is a flagship scheme launched by Hon'ble Prime Minister in September, 2019 for control of Foot & Mouth Disease and Brucellosis by vaccinating 100% cattle, buffalo, sheep, goat and pig population for FMD and 100% bovine female calves of 4-8 months of age for brucellosis. The overall aim of the National Animal Disease Control Programme for FMD and Brucellosis (NADCP) is to control FMD by 2025 with vaccination and its eventual eradication by 2030, and to control Brucellosis in livestock which will result in effective management of the disease, in both animals and in humans.

2.2 Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM): The Government of India (2016-17) added Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM) as the third component under NPBBDD and Indigenous Breed with a 100% funding by the Government of India with the aim and objectives to improve the genetic makeup of the indigenous breeds for better milk production, to upgrade non-descript cattle using elite indigenous breeds like Gir, Sahiwal, Tharparkar and Red Sindhi, to bring all breedable female cattle under organized breeding through Artificial Insemination at the farmer's doorsteps. It also aims to conserve, develop and proliferate selected indigenous bovine breeds of high socio-economic importance and also to provide quality breeding inputs in breeding tracts of important indigenous breeds so as to prevent the breeds from deterioration and extinction.

2.3. Administrative Investigation and Statistics: -

(a) Sample Survey for estimation of Major Livestock products: - The production of major livestock products (MLP) namely milk, eggs, meat and wool are estimated on the basis of annual sample surveys conducted under the Central Sector Scheme "Integrated Sample Survey". The scheme is implemented by the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying through State Animal Husbandry Departments. All States & UTs are implementing the scheme. Surveys conducted in entire rural and urban areas of the States and UTs. The survey period is from March to February and the entire period of one year is divided into 4 months each. This helps in bringing up progressive estimates of aggregates and also takes care of seasonality if any in the characters under study.

From the year 2021 (Monsoon Season) onwards, in this survey the traditional approach of using paper schedules for filling-in information at the field level is replaced by the Computer Assisted Personal Interviewing (CAPI) method. The data is being directly entered into the tablets by the field workers using a specialized software developed by the Department of A.H. & Dairying, GOI called "eLISS".

The Scheme with the funding pattern of **90:10 basis** between State and Central continue to function till date with the objective to estimate production level of Major Livestock Products such as Milk, Meat and Eggs in the State to build up database in A.H. & Sector required for planning purpose.

(b) Livestock Census continues to function during the year under report for conducting the Quinquennial Livestock Census in the State with 100% Central Assistance. So far, 20 livestock censuses have been conducted. Livestock Census is a complete count of the livestock and poultry at pre-defined reference point of time. Similar to population census, primary workers are engaged to undertake house to house enumeration and ascertain the number, age, sex, etc., of livestock/poultry possessed by every household/household enterprise/non-household/non-household enterprises and institutions in rural & urban areas of the country. For the first time tablet computers were used for conduct of 20th livestock census.


