Respected Shri Sanbor Shullai Ji,

I would like to draw your attention to the issue of uniformity in payment of internship allowance in respect of students of the final year of the BVSc & AH degree programme with other States. The Minimum Standards of Veterinary Education Regulations, 2016 (MSVE) prescribe that during the period of internship, among other things, the intern shall be paid consolidated remuneration in the form of internship allowance, as may be decided by the University or Institution from to time. However, the allowance provided by the university vary compared to other States.

You may appreciate that the regulations provide for Bachelor of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry (BVSc & AH) to undergo a compulsory internship of "one year" duration after successful completion of all credits as prescribed in the syllabus. The internship programme includes entrepreneurial training as well.

The students undertake rotating internship at veterinary hospitals, polyclinic, zoo, livestock production & management unit, livestock product technology unit, disease diagnostic laboratories, etc. Internship training include training in veterinary and animal husbandry services (including attending to emergencies and night duties, holidays, etc.) and interns are required to devote full time to the training and not allowed to accept any whole time or part time employment.

Bringing uniform and reasonable allowance would not only help interns to meet out the increasing cost of living expenses and outstation internship duties but will also help infuse confidence and inspire them to look forward to meet the veterinary competencies with much enthusiasm.

Accordingly, I would request for your personal intervention for enhancing the internship allowance. I am enclosing a copy of the requisite information gathered from some of the States for your ready reference so that States could work towards making such allowances uniform as far as possible.
